## Quadrant RASWIN Release Note – 9/8/2014 – Version 1.0.4369 or later

1. The startup processing steps have been modified so that any necessary database update steps (processed by SQL Script commands) are run automatically if need be. When the first workstation that runs the new version runs, it will run the scripts if they have not already been run and copy some of the older scripts into a SAVE directory for save keeping.

The scripts that are run will be added to a new table called SQL\_SCRIPT\_COMPLETIONS and checked each time the program attempts to run them. If the specific script is already listed in the table, the program knows it does not need to run them a second time. Therefore, regardless of which workstation the program is first started from, it will know whether the scripts have been run or not as opposed to the older method which relied on local files.

In order to secure a copy of the latest script list and the scripts themselves you must currently use the RASWIN\_SETUP.EXE program file and run it. We plan to create a new 'stripped down' setup that will contain only the files that have changed since the last full setup which will reduce the size of the download and the time required to run it. This will be done over the next month or two.

The setup process will replace the requirement to run the SQLUPDATER.EXE program file. During the setup, this file will be deleted from your local drive if it is found and it will no longer be included in the RASWIN\_SETUP.EXE installation file.
